This includes, but is not limited to, the assessment of referred patients, the development of a care plan, working to reduce and control pain and other symptoms with patients and working in cooperation with different stakeholders to ensure that the patient's quality of life has improved.

Role Requirements:

The appointed individual is expected to have the following experience and qualifications:

- Nursing Qualification – Professional Nurse
- Interest in Palliative Care
- 5 – 10 years' experience in patient care
- Evidence of palliative care training or experience will be an advantage
- Registration with the South African Nursing Council
- Driver's licence and ability to drive
- Able to communicate effectively in local languages – Tsonga, Sepedi and English
- Willingness to conduct household visits
- Report writing skills
- Supervision of caregivers placed at households

The Palliative Care Nurse must be passionate and compassionate towards patients and their families. They must have good communication skills and be able to address life-threatening and end-of-life illness with the patient and the family. They must work well with other external stakeholders in the multi-disciplinary team to ensure the patient's needs are being addressed. The Palliative Care Nurse must be assertive and able to advocate on behalf of the patient. She must be target-driven and able to balance her workload appropriately.
